



# Important Information for Campers



## What to Wear:

- Casual clothes for the day: modest shorts/t-shirts.
- Swimming:
  - Guys – MODEST swimsuits no higher than mid-thigh. T-shirts must be worn to and from the swimming area.
  - Girls – MODEST one-piece swimsuits. A large T-shirt or non-transparent cover-up must be worn to and from the swimming area.

## What NOT to Wear:

- Shorts, tops, skirts, etc., that are too tight.
- Short shorts (hem no shorter than fingertips when arm is extended).
- Halter tops, tube tops, cut-off shirts, or cropped tops or shirts that don't meet your pants or rise up when arms are raised.
- T-shirts with distasteful designs or messages.
- Bikinis, French-cut, or one-piece resembling two-piece swimsuits.
- Spaghetti-strap tops (unless you have a shirt underneath).

## What to Pack:

- Bible, notebook, pen
- Toiletry items
- Bath towels
- Linens:

☞ **Georgia Baptist Conference Center** – All bed linens are already supplied (pillow, sheets, and blanket).

☞ **Stephen F. Austin State University** - Campers must bring bed linens (pillow, twin bed sheets and blanket or sleeping bag).

☞ **Liberty University** – Campers must bring bed linens (pillow, twin bed sheets and blanket or sleeping bag).

☞ **Campbellsville University** – Campers must bring bed linens (pillow, twin bed sheets and blanket or sleeping bag).

☞ **Wesleyan College** – Campers must bring bed linens (pillow, twin bed sheets and blanket or sleeping bag).

- Limited spending money. Some optional recreation activities require a small fee. Christian resources may be purchased. In addition, vending machines and snack shops are available.

## What NOT to Pack:

- Any item that is illegal, dangerous, or may be used to cause damage to the camp facility or harm an individual (examples: alcoholic beverages, drugs, fireworks, weapons, water balloons, or water guns, etc.).
- Tobacco products – GO TELL Camp has a no-tobacco policy.
- Radios, cd/tape players, video game equipment, cell phones, or pagers to be used inappropriately. The use of two-way communication devices is prohibited except by camp staff or counselors.

GO TELL Camps reserve the right to collect any item that violates the above provisions.

**First Aid/Medication:** Medical personnel will be on duty throughout the week of camp. All serious cases of sickness or injury should be reported to the medical staff immediately.

**Valuables:** GO TELL Ministries and each GO TELL Camp venue cannot accept responsibility for missing items. Therefore, it is advised that campers not bring unnecessary valuables to camp. Each camper is responsible for his/her own cash and valuable items.
