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Children's Leader Checklist

Before you arrive at GO TELL Camp, you should...

- Register online by paying a \$50 deposit per person...**

Visit www.gotellministries.com to register your group online!

Pay online with a credit card, debit card, or automatic draft from your checking account. GO TELL accepts American Express, MasterCard, Visa, or Discover. You may also mail a Registration Form to the GO TELL office. Please include a check for your deposit of \$50 per person. Make checks payable to GO TELL Ministries.

*Deposits must be received in the GO TELL office **ON OR BEFORE** the deadline specified in the *Camp Costs and Discounts* form to receive the priority registration rates for your group.

*Please remember that deposits are non-refundable.

*Number of spaces is held ONLY as deposits are received.

Please read carefully the Financial Policies and Procedures form so that you fully understand these items and do not incur any additional expenses.

Recruit counselors so that you have 1 counselor for every 7 students.

If you bring female students, you must have female counselors; if you bring male students, you must have male counselors. (The registration cost for counselors is the same as it is for students. Please remind your counselors that GO TELL provides excellent breakout groups for the adults too!)

Have a parent meeting. (THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT!)

At this meeting:

- Provide parents instructions to fill out students' medical release forms **online**. (A link will be sent to you that you can forward to the parents.) Manual medical release forms are no longer available. If any parents are unable to complete the forms online, you may obtain the information from them and complete those for your group.
- Pass out "Important Information for Students" forms enclosed.
- Pass out the "Prayer Request Form", included in this guide, to your parents and have them fill it out and send back to our office. We want to pray for you and your students specifically!
- Show the promo videos. You may download this from our website or contact our office to receive the video in a DVD format.
- Have the counselors fill out medical release forms **online**. (A link will be sent to you that you can forward along to your counselors.)
- Pray for a great week of camp!

Complete a background check on every adult in your group, including the bus driver! Background checks MUST be current – i.e., completed within the last twelve months. Print off the "Background Check and Certification Form" included in this guide, sign the form, and fax it to GO TELL at 770-622-5603. You may also mail it to GO TELL at P.O. Box 2138 Duluth, GA 30096.

If you would like to have your background checks done online you may go to the forms page on our camp website (www.gotellministries.com), and click on the link for Data Facts. These forms must be submitted by the due date listed below!

Submit final payment, program fee, rooming breakdown, and t-shirt orders online by the due date listed below. Again, you may pay online by credit card, debit card, or automatic draft from your checking account. (You may also make checks payable to Go Tell Ministries.

- **Pay deposits, final balances, and program fees online - it's easy!**
Visit www.gotellcamps.com to pay by credit card, debit card, or automatic draft from your checking account. GO TELL accepts American Express, MasterCard, Visa, and Discover. If you need assistance in logging into your online account, please contact the GO TELL office at 1-866-I-GO-TELL.
- Checks can also be mailed to P.O. Box 2138 Duluth, GA 30096. Please make checks payable to Go Tell Ministries. Payments MUST be received by the due date listed above.
- **Submit rooming breakdowns and t-shirt orders online!** If you need assistance logging in to fill this information in, please contact the GO TELL Office at 1-866-I-GO-TELL.

LATE FINAL BALANCE

Should you not comply with the above policies; the following procedures will be followed:

- 1) **Your space will be fully forfeited** if any churches are being held on a waiting list. It is not the obligation of GO TELL Ministries to notify you. Your deposits will not be returned. (If space is available, you may be able to attend another week of camp.)
- 2) If your church is able to attend your originally scheduled week, **you will be charged a late fee of \$100** for the first day after the due date that your payment was not received. Each subsequent business day will be another \$25. **Any late fees incurred must be paid before arriving at camp.** Rooming will be divided 50/50 (guys/girls) if payment and/or rooming breakdown information is received after the due date.

REFUNDS

To be eligible for refunds of the final payment and program fee, you must notify us in writing of changes to your group's final count prior to or by 4:00 p.m. eastern time on the "DUE" dates listed above. **Failure to do so obligates your church to pay the final balance for the number of registrations (determined by paid deposits) that we are holding for your church as of the due date.** All refunds will be processed within 10 business days of the end of your camp week. ***There is no eligibility for refunds after the dates listed in the "Due Date" column.***

While we sympathize with situations that are outside of your control, including illness, family situations, etc., we cannot refund your camp balance after the due dates above. As of this due date, GO TELL Ministries is committed to pay all costs, such as facility fees, lodging, meals and other fees related to camp.

CAMP CANCELLATION POLICY

Should camp be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances which are outside of our control, including but not limited to national disasters, weather conditions, etc., deposits remain non-refundable. Camp balances may be refunded if the facilities utilized refund GO TELL Ministries. This may vary by location.

If your church group chooses not to come to camp due to weather conditions, and the camp is still held as scheduled, all payments are non-refundable.

It is our desire for camp to be a positive experience for everyone involved. We are here to help you in any way possible. Remember, if you follow the guidelines in your registration information, you will not incur late fees or forfeited monies. Thank you for your help in this important area!

BACKGROUND CHECK VERIFICATION FORM

GO TELL’s primary concern is for the safety and well-being of all the students who attend camp. Therefore, GO TELL requires that a criminal background check be completed on every adult who attends camp. It is the responsibility of each youth pastor/group leader to verify that a background check has been performed **within the last 12 months**, and is on file at his/her church, for EVERY ADULT ATTENDING CAMP WITH HIS/HER GROUP. (This means that a criminal background check should be on file for all youth pastors, parent volunteers, other chaperones, and bus drivers.)

Data Facts, Inc. is an excellent source for obtaining criminal background checks. Our contact at Data Facts is Ann Easton, and her cell phone number is **(901) 331-1367**. Ann will be able to assist you in obtaining all of the necessary forms and paperwork.

CAMPER INFORMATION

What to Wear:

- Casual clothes for the day: modest shorts/t-shirts.
- Swimming:
 - Guys – MODEST swimsuits no higher than mid-thigh.
T-shirts must be worn to and from the swimming area.
 - Girls – MODEST one-piece swimsuits or modest Tankinis (must cover your stomach). A large **dark** T-shirt or cover-up must be worn to and from the swimming area.
 - **One-piece bathing suits must be worn while tubing and water skiing on the lake.**

What NOT to Wear:

- Shorts, tops, skirts, etc., that are too tight.
- Short shorts (hem no shorter than fingertips when arm is extended).
- Skimpy Tops (Halter, etc.) or shirts that don't meet your pants or rise up above your pants when arms are raised.
 - T-shirts with distasteful designs or messages.
 - Bikinis, Tankinis, French-cut, or one-piece resembling two-piece swimsuits.
 - Spaghetti-strap tops (unless you have a shirt underneath).
 - Pants that are too low cut and don't allow you to bend over without being embarrassed!



What to Pack:

- Bible, notebook, pen
- Toiletry items
- Bath towels (These are required at all camp venues. Recommend that students bring unique patterns and colors to keep things separate in their rooms)
- Linens:
 - ☞ **Georgia Baptist Conference Center** – All bed linens are already supplied (pillow, sheets, and blanket).
- Limited spending money. Some optional recreation activities require a small fee. Christian resources may be purchased. In addition, vending machines and snack shops are available.

What NOT to Pack:

- Any item that is illegal, dangerous, or may be used to cause damage to the camp facility or harm an individual (examples: alcoholic beverages, drugs, fireworks, weapons, water balloons, or water guns, etc.).
- Tobacco products – GO TELL Camp has a no-tobacco policy.
- Radios, cd/tape players, video game equipment, cell phones, or pagers to be used inappropriately. The use of two-way communication devices is prohibited except by camp staff or counselors.

GO TELL Camps reserve the right to collect any item that violates the above provisions.

First Aid/Medication

Medical personnel will be on duty throughout the week of camp. All serious cases of sickness or injury should be reported to the medical staff immediately.

Valuables

GO TELL Ministries and each GO TELL Camp venue cannot accept responsibility for missing items. Therefore, it is advised that campers not bring unnecessary valuables to camp. Each camper is responsible for his/her own cash and valuable items.
